

## Finding Obituaries Using America's News Free Online Service

America's News is a comprehensive news, information and obituary service provided by NewsBank, inc. It offers news at the local, state, regional and national levels through many libraries in the United States. Many obituaries printed in the last 10 or 20 years are available.

Here are the steps to access America's News Online Service through the Thousand Oaks Library:

- Obtain a library card from the Thousand Oaks Library
- Go to <https://www.tolibrary.org/> in a Web browser
- Click on Virtual Library, click on eResources A to Z in the left column, and then click on America's News
- Enter your Thousand Oaks Library card number and pin number
- Type in what you are searching in the search box

### Search Tips

- Put quotation marks around the name of the person you are trying to find, e.g., "Emma Lee Price". This search will find all articles containing this exact character string.
- Type in variants of the name to find all pertinent articles, e.g., "Emma Lee Price", "Emma L. Price", "Emma Price", and "Price, Emma Lee".
- Type in common misspellings of the name such as "Emily Price"
- Reduce the number of search results by searching on multiple phases at once, e.g., "Helen Crise" "Bruce Crise"
- Reduce the number of search results by including an affiliation in the search string, e.g., "Timmons" "Conejo Valley Genealogical Society"
- Reduce the number of search results by clicking on More Search Options, Advanced Search, or New Search to filter your search by date, date range, or geographic region
- Use wildcards such as ? or \* in a search when you are unsure of spelling or when you want to include multiple forms of a word. The ? represents any single character. The \* represents any one or more characters, for example, "M?rl\*" will find occurrences of Marlatt, Morlet, Marlotte, Merladt, etc.
- Parentheses can help with complex searches. You can also use Boolean operators such as AND, OR, NOT, e.g., ("Martin" AND "King") NOT ("Martin Luther King")
- To find obituaries, consider adding these keywords to your search string: "obituar\*", "memorial", "funeral", "survivors", "deaths", "death", "died", "born". For example: "Martha Grace Griffith" AND ("memorial" OR "funeral" OR "survivors")
- To search a specific database, use Quick Links on the main search page, or click All Databases. Some newspapers that can be searched are the Ventura Star, Thousand Oaks Acorn, and Daily New. The Ventura Star is a popular paper for local obituaries.

**Emma Lee Price** Thousand Oaks, CA **Emma Lee Price**, a long time resident of Thousand Oaks, CA, passed away peacefully in March 2016 in her home in Yorba Linda at the age of 94. Born in Adams County, Illinois, she lived in Thousand Oaks from 1963 to 2000 and was an active member of Emmanuel Presbyterian Church and the Conejo Valley Genealogy Society. She moved to Orange County, CA in 2000 to be closer to family. Emma Lee lived a long and remarkable life, and is fondly remembered by the former students and staff of Redwood Middle School in Thousand Oaks, where she taught Home Economics and Math from 1966 to 1986.
